Portland Boxing Club's Kate Zehr and pro middleweight Russell "The Haitian Sensation" Lamour, Jr. both scored victories at the Skowhegan Pro-Am show promoted by Team Berry Boxing at the Skowhegan Community Center on December 1.

PBC's Kate Zehr, of South Portland, a novice class featherweight (125 lbs), kept her winning streak alive, winning her eighth fight in a row. Zehr won a hard-fought battle by a close split decision over Willow Crawford, of Goffstown, NH.

In the six-round co-main event of the evening, PBC's Russell Lamour, of Portland, a professional middleweight (160 lbs), won by technical knock-out in the fourth round over the veteran Larry Smith, of Dallas, TX. Lamour looked impressive in his comeback showing sharp boxing skills. After a tentative first round, Lamour scored three knock downs that included a brutal body attack.
