All-Star Boxing at the Portland Expo

After a two year hiatus due to Covid-19, the Portland Boxing Club will present its 106th event held here in Portland. Headlining the pro portion of the event will be Casey "The Comeback Kid" Streeter who meets up with Khiary Gray of Worcester MA for the New England Super Welterweight Championship. The co-feature is the return of PBC fan favorite former National Middleweight Champion Russell "The Haitian Sensation" Lamour, as well as former National Golden Gloves Super Bantamweight Champion Jorge "Mantequilla" Abiague.




Shelter Sleep-In

100% of funds raised at this event support the ARLGP and the 4,000 animals they have helped this year, a cause that Kate is compassionate about. Join her



In 2007, Coombs and the Portland Boxing Club filed suit against USA Boxing to end discrimination against women boxers at the national level. USA Boxing settled the suit and agreed to provide equal treatment for women at national events.


