

The co-feature will be the return of PBC fan favorite former National Golden Gloves Champion and New England Super Bantamweight Champion Jorge "Mantequilla" Abiague. Abiague will face Eder Clervoix of Montreal, Quebec by way of Port-au-Prince, Haiti. This eight-round bout is for the vacant Northeastern Super Bantamweight Championship.

Also on the card is the popular welterweight Brandon "The Cannon" Berry from West Forks, Maine and other up-and-coming professional boxers from around New England. The show will open with several amateur bouts featuring Portland Boxing Club's rising stars.

The special guest for the event will be announced soon. Tickets go on sale on October 1, 2022 at www.portlandboxingclub.org and at Bruno's Restaurant, 33 Allen Avenue, Portland, as well as at the door the night of the event. Ticket prices range from \$25 to \$100.




